# What's an SAI?

## Student Aid Index

The SAI is a number that represents all the information you and your parents provided on the FAFSA.

College financial aid offices use the SAI to determine your eligibility for federal and state financial assistance.





SAI is a rebranding of EFC (Expected Family Contribution) in an effort to more accurately reflect what this number represents.



The SAI number helps colleges identify financial need and determine how much financial aid to award.



The SAI does not represent an amount your parent must pay for their child's college education.



# How is the SAI Calculated?

The SAI is calculated using a methodology established by law.

Some of the factors used include:

Family income

Size of household

Available assets and benefits



# What's Next?

## The Aid Offer

- Colleges will use the SAI to determine financial aid eligibility
- Once financial aid is determined, they will send a Financial Aid Offer via email or postal mail
- Most colleges send these offers in the spring
- The aid offer will include the Cost of Attendance and the amount of financial aid being offered
- Students must accept or decline their award package



# Sample Financial Aid Offer

Your financial aid offer details the costs of attending a college for an academic year

Additionally, it lists any grants, student loans, scholarships, or work-study you're eligible to receive at that college
