

Let's Go to College: Career Discovery (Kindergarten-1st Grade)

Are there certain jobs that really excite you, like being an astronaut or a police officer? Learning more about these, and others, can help you see a world of possibilities. When you go to college you'll explore different careers, job duties and work tools. Job duties are tasks people do to meet their job requirements, and work tools are the items people use to help them perform those requirements. thermometer for her.**

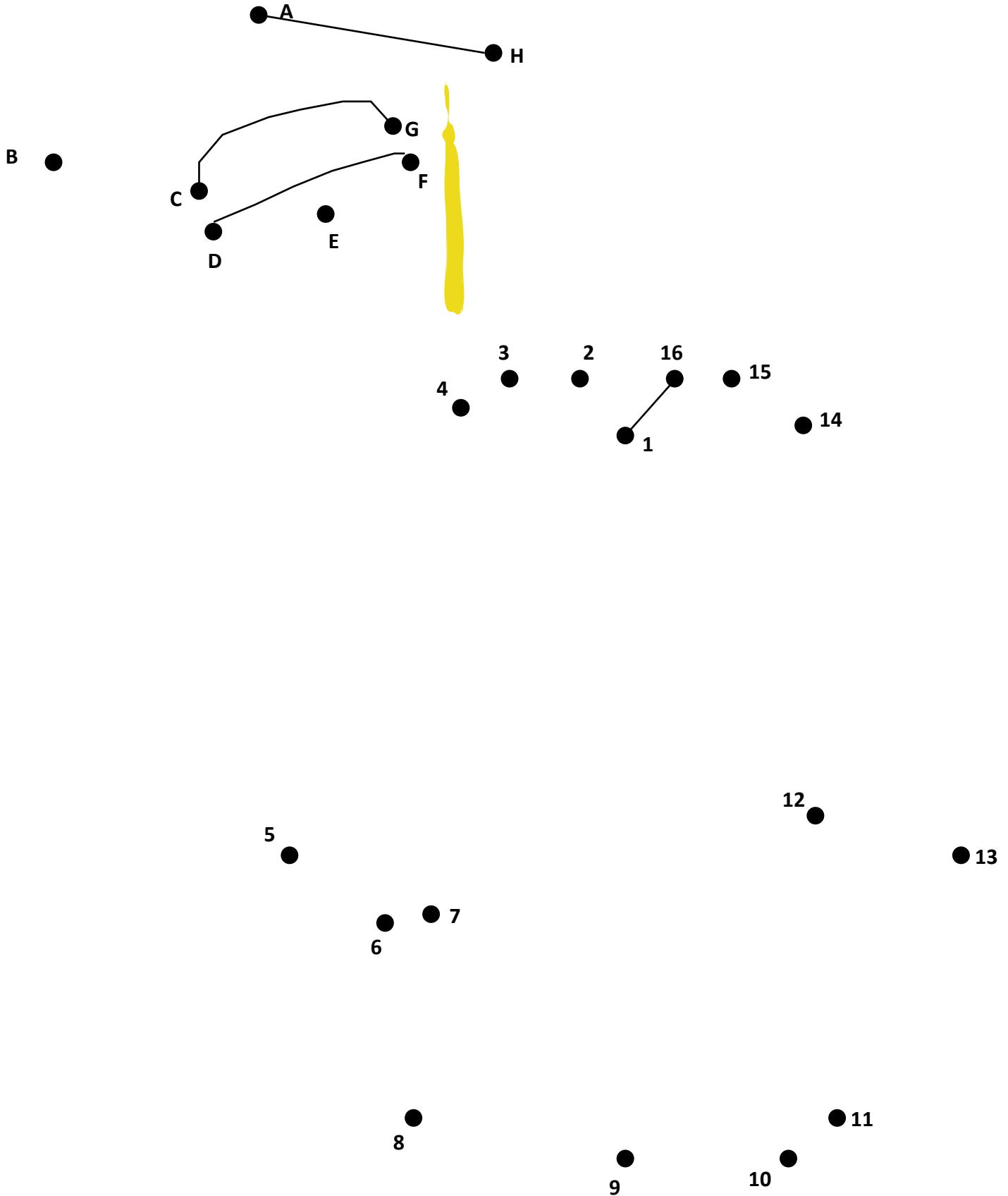
**Cody is a sports coach who is missing his
