### FAFSA

- The FAFSA, or Free Application for Federal Student Aid, is your first step in applying for federal and state financial aid programs.
- Complete the FAFSA every year for financial aid to help with college expenses.
- Find the 2025-26 FAFSA at <u>FAFSA.gov</u> on or before December 1, 2024.
- To access and sign the FAFSA, students and parents will need to create a StudentAid.gov account at <u>StudentAid.gov</u>.





### Why should you complete the FAFSA?

Used to determine your eligibility for financial aid

Also used to apply for some forms of state aid

Required each year for Oklahoma's Promise scholarship recipients

New graduation requirement for all 2024-25 public high school seniors



### **FAFSA Facts**

The high school class of 2023 left more than \$4 billion in Pell Grants on the table by not completing the FAFSA.

By 2031, 72% of jobs in the U.S. will require postsecondary education and/or training. Seniors who complete the FAFSA are 84% more likely to immediately enroll in postsecondary education.

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## **Personal Information**

Enter your name exactly how it appears on your Social Security card.

Enter the correct month, date and year of your birth.

Enter your Social Security Number accurately.



### Username and Password

Username can be 6-30 characters long—a combination of letters and numbers. Not case sensitive.

Create and confirm your password; 8-30 characters long—a combination of numbers, upper- and lowercase letters.

Choose 'Show Password' to see the information you're entering.

### Account Information

Because financial aid agreements are legally binding, you can't create an account for someone else, even another family member. Parents and students must create their own accounts.

# Verify Email & Phone Number

Student Aid will send a code to your cell phone and/or your email address. You'll provide the code here to set up your StudentAid.gov account. The code will serve as confirmation of the information you've provided.

### Step 7 of 7 Account Recovery

Only a verified email address OR a verified mobile phone number is required, but if you provided both on previous screens, you MUST verify both below.





### **Two-Step Authentication**

Installing an Authenticator App isn't required, but it's recommended as an added way to keep your information safe and secure.

You can download your own Authenticator App, or set one up directly from the StudentAid.gov account creation screen.

### Where Can I Use My StudentAid.gov Account?

- Confirmation of your StudentAid.gov account can take up to a week.
- Once your account has been confirmed, you can use it to sign your FAFSA and access other Federal Student Aid websites.
  - Complete student loan paperwork and the Master Promissory Note (MPN)
  - Student loan entrance and exit counseling
  - Monitor student loan balances
  - Apply for student loan discharge under certain circumstances
